Category 7 (Divisions 1, 2, 3 & 5) will have a time limit as follows: The contestant must work on a project of similar nature of that of completed project before the judges on the conference and national levels. The contestant must present one completed project for judging.

Category 7 (Division 4): All contestants shall present one photograph (minimum of 8x10), for ultimate judging. However, the contestant must present a portfolio of five (5) photographs for discussion and interview purposes with the judges.

Penalties:

Talent presentations exceeding the time limit will be penalized one (1) point for each second over the limit.

- Penalty points shall be subtracted from total points earned.
- Three timekeepers shall be appointed on each level of competition. Timekeepers will submit their time sheets to the chairman of judges who shall determine what, if any, penalty shall be assessed.
- Any violation of requirements for art contestants will result in a five (5) point penalty for each violation.
- Penalty points will be subtracted from total points earned.
